Created in the 1960s by French actor, nightclub owner and cabaret artist Jean-Marie Rivière, his secret hideaway

quickly became a magnet for the pretty young things that hung out in his Parisian nightclub. Later, when it became a hotel, it retained this exuberant mood with playful interiors that referenced the 1950s heyday of the island. This year, La Banane has made the transition to private rental property, allowing you to

have the beauty of its location and vibrant décor all to yourself and your own private guest list. Its nine bungalows are bright and airy, with splashes of colour to lift the senses. It's also equipped with a cocktail bar and two gloriously palm-shaded pools – at this decadent villa you'll lose yourself in style.
