For a contemporary or trending interior design style, our faux leather covered shutters truly create a statement in luxury bathrooms. The faux leather is stain resistant, easily wiped clean, UV stable and will not stretch, nor fade in sunlight.

The size of your window is a crucial aspect of your shutter design and style. A tall but narrow window could have one large shutter which will make the room feel larger. Short, but wide windows, will be best suited to having multiple

thinner panels in order to enhance the window opening. Those with square windows would benefit from having three narrow shutter panels, which will give the illusion of greater window height. A wall of 'floor to ceiling' glazing is accentuated with tall and wide sliding shutter panels.
